Child Find

The Hanson School District 30-1 is required by law and conscience to provide appropriate educational opportunities for all children, regardless of their special educational needs. The district conducts an annual "Child Find" search to identify and evaluate all district children, birth through 21, who may be in need of and benefit from special education services. All children of the district are eligible for services, whether they attend public or non-public schools. Any person that is aware of a child in this district with unserved educational needs is asked to contact the Elementary Principal at 239-4387. After children are referred and parental consent is obtained, the district will conduct an evaluation of the child's needs and a placement meeting will be held.
